

Prof. Klaus-Jürgen Etzold (*1959)



He is director of music at Studienseminar Hanover for grammar school instructors. In addition, he has been working as an honorary professor at Hanover University of Music, Drama and Media since 1995. From 1978 until 1986 he was assistant of Prof. Heinz Hennig, the conductor of the Hanover Boys Choir. In 1980 he was co-founder of, and until 1985 a solo singer in the Orlando di Lasso-Ensemble Hannover. He received the conductor's prize in the international choral competitions in Riva del Garda/Italy (1994), in Torrevieja/Spain (2006) and in Panyu/China (2010). He is a co-lecturer of choral music (CHORISSIMO by Carus Verlag) and quite often adjudicator in national and international choral competitions. For 20 years he was member in the Choral Board of the German Music Council.
